November moon

November is an exciting month for moon-gazing.

In North America, the full moon this month can be observed Friday, November 19th at 2:59 AM CST.

This year, the full moon on the 19th is accompanied with a partial lunar eclipse! An eclipse is when the Moon, Sun and Earth are in a line with Earth in the middle. The Earth's position causes the planet's shadow to be cast onto the Moon giving it a red colour.

The November moon phases have also been named after animal activity as they prepare for winter. One name is the "Beaver" Moon. The name "Beaver" Moon comes from [the Farmer's Almanac](#) that used to name the monthly full Moons after Native American and European folklore. Some other animal-related names that have been used are: "Digging Moon" (after animals who forage for food and make dens in the ground) and the "Deer Rutting Moon" (after the time of year when deer are seeking mates). The Moon has also been called the Frost Moon and the Freezing Moon because winter is coming soon!
