"Fall" – so much more than classes!

In the Northern Hemisphere, Wednesday, September 22nd marks "Autumnal equinox" or, the first day of the "fall" season.

The word "equinox" comes from two Latin words meaning "equal," and "night." but, what does this mean?

On the 22nd, the sun crosses the plane of the equator making day and night of equal length; the sun doesn't rise as early and it goes down sooner in the evening than it did in the summer.
