September 30th – National Day for Truth and Reconciliation



Establishing a national holiday to commemorate the tragic legacy of residential schools in Canada creates an opportunity to educate and remind Canadians about the history of residential schools, honour the victims and celebrate the survivors.

This date coincides with Orange Shirt Day, which began in 2012 and involves wearing orange shirts to honour Indigenous children forced to leave their families to attend residential schools. The USLC Tuesday workshop: “What does Orange Shirt Day mean to you?” will allow students to hear from Residential school survivors their thoughts and feelings about Orange Shirt Day.
