Why is Monday a holiday in Canada?



To celebrate the reigning Queen in 1845, [Queen Victoria's](#) birthday was declared a holiday: [Victoria Day](#). But, it was not until her death in 1901 that an act of Parliament established it as a legal holiday to be celebrated every year on May 24th (or the last Monday before May 25th).

Queen Victoria was an important influence in the creation of Canada as a country and it was she who selected our capital city: [Ottawa](#). This Victoria day holiday also unofficially marks the start of summer in Canada and is commonly celebrated with parades and fireworks!
