Riverbank wildlife in Saskatoon

The [South Saskatchewan River](#) runs through Saskatoon and is host to many different wildlife. Two of the most frequently seen and enjoyed are the White American Pelicans and the beavers.

The [American White Pelican](#) (photo above) migrates north each year in the spring. They find a place to nest and make that home for the summer months. In Saskatoon, a regular nesting site is the Wier along the river. You can visit the pelicans and watch them fish and soar high with their massive wingspan!



Beavers are nocturnal (they only come out at night usually) and when they do, they are looking for trees to cut down to build their dam. [Considered “ecosystem engineers”](#), beavers help to manage water levels and water pollution. [There have been more sightings of beavers](#) or evidence of them this year because of more trees being cut down. [Check out this busy beaver](#) by a bridge in Saskatoon.
