#### Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee

Canada is a <u>constitutional monarchy</u>. What this means is that Canada's executive powers are <u>vested</u> in the Queen through our Constitution making the crown (the Queen) our head of state.

This does not mean the Queen rules Canada. Every act of government is carried out in the name of the Crown, but the authority for these flows from the Canadian people through their elected government. The Queen acts as a ceremonial role entrusting the governing of Canada to its government.

February 2022 marked the Queen's 70<sup>th</sup> year of service in her role as Canada's head of state making her the longest serving monarch to date. June 2-5, 2022 were established as days of celebration of this occasion. <u>See photos and events</u> here.
